

# Abstract Collage and Printmaking Materials List

Students will receive a pound of vintage paper and can purchase additional paper from Sarah.

Sarah will provide much of what is needed, but it is required that you provide the following supplies:

- Scissors
- Small self-healing cutting mat
- Ruler
- Utility knife or Exacto knife
- Brayer (preferably two - one for using with matte medium and one for paint) I prefer a 4" for printmaking and a 1.5" for matte medium
- Glue brush - an inexpensive one-inch brush with stiff bristles that you'll be using with matte medium
- Golden matte medium
- Apron or something to protect your clothes
- Pencil and notebook for taking notes
- Golden Open Paint (3-5 colors) in a palette of your choice. (2 oz tubes or a set with the .75 oz tubes are fine)
- Golden SoFlat Matte Paint in black (2 oz jar is enough)

Note about paints: These are specialty paints that local retailers do not often stock. I suggest that you order them online from Blick Art Materials. These specific paints will provide the best results for the techniques you'll learn in this class.
